IRDAI has authorized Insurance Institute of India for conducting training program for CEOs/CAOs of TPA. Initially, all existing CEOs/CAOs of TPA cos. shall undergo training program under class room method for a duration of 21 hours spread over to 3 days including evaluation module. Later there shall be an online module for refresher training after the span of every 3 years. At the end of the training session; certificate will be issued by III. The course content and training module under developing stage with the III. The announcement of this training program will be made shortly.
