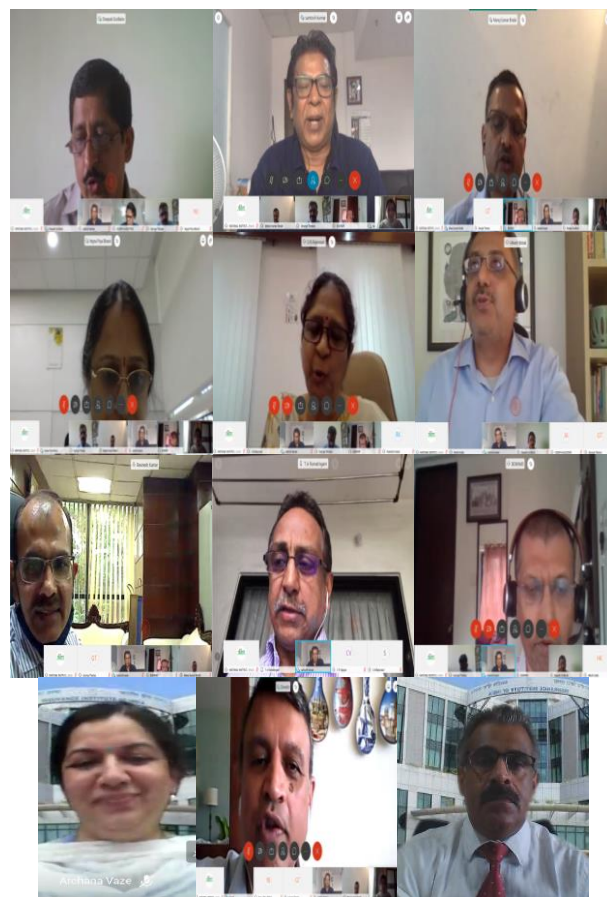

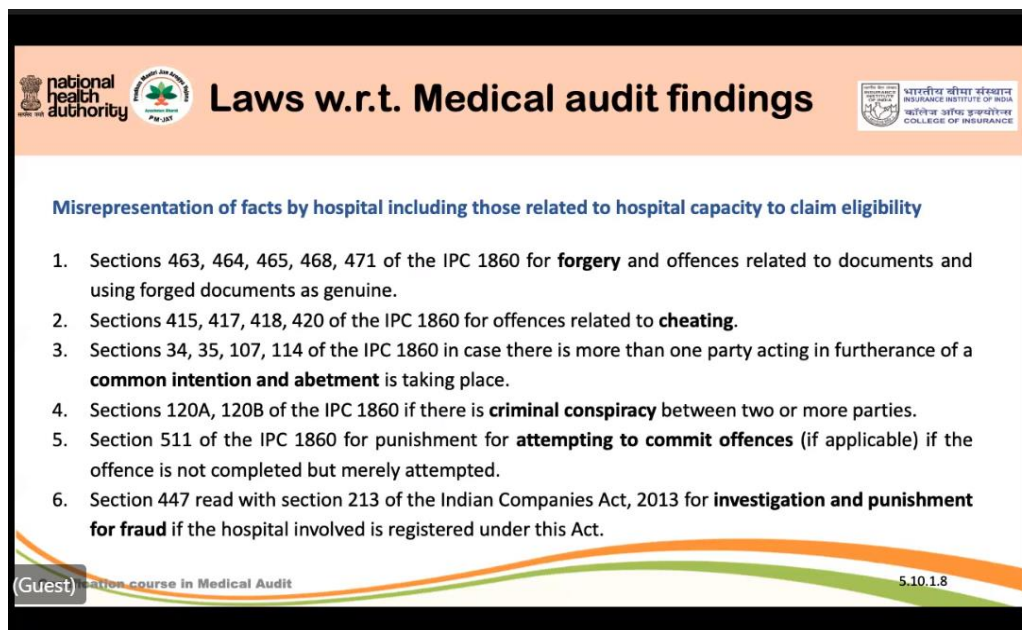

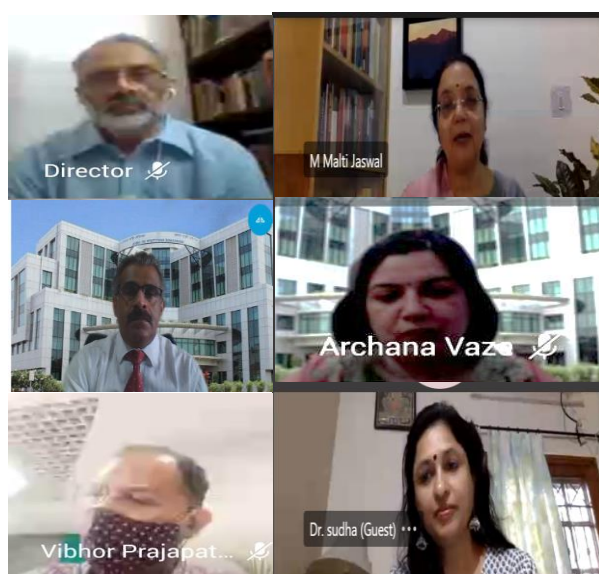

Laws w.r.t. Medical audit findings

Misrepresentation of facts by hospital including those related to hospital capacity to claim eligibility

1. Sections 463, 464, 465, 468, 471 of the IPC 1860 for **forgery** and offences related to documents and using forged documents as genuine.
2. Sections 415, 417, 418, 420 of the IPC 1860 for offences related to **cheating**.
3. Sections 34, 35, 107, 114 of the IPC 1860 in case there is more than one party acting in furtherance of a **common intention and abetment** is taking place.
4. Sections 120A, 120B of the IPC 1860 if there is **criminal conspiracy** between two or more parties.
5. Section 511 of the IPC 1860 for punishment for **attempting to commit offences** (if applicable) if the offence is not completed but merely attempted.
6. Section 447 read with section 213 of the Indian Companies Act, 2013 for **investigation and punishment for fraud** if the hospital involved is registered under this Act.

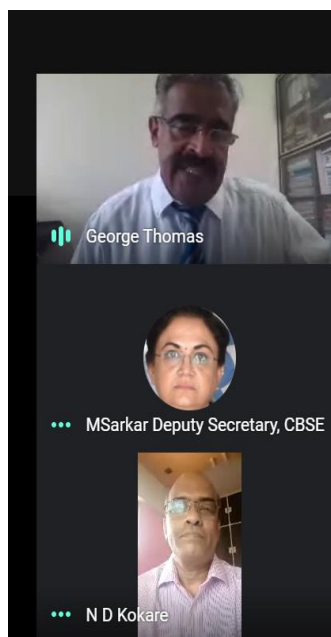
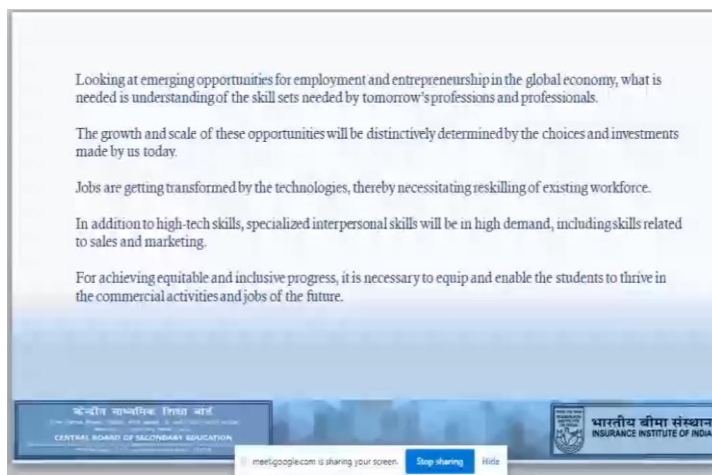

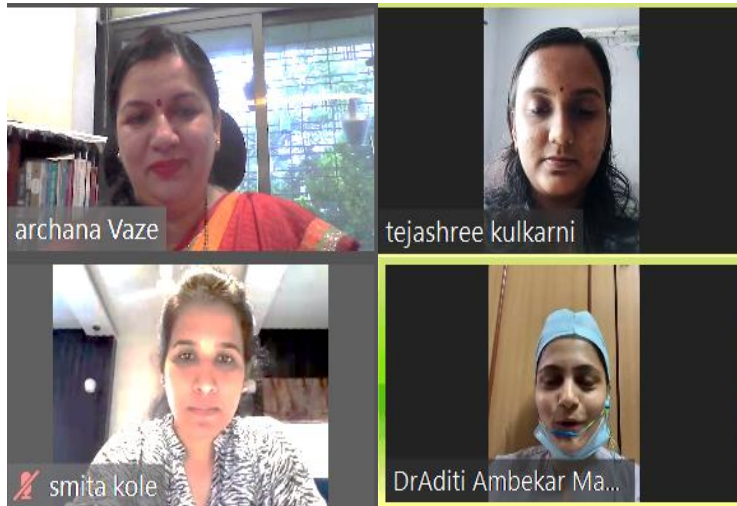
