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DIA-MOW gives multiple stakeholders a broad understanding of Disaster Risk Financing, how the insurance mechanism works and how the insurance industry is kept solvent through global regulatory frameworks and prudential practices. The importance of developing a governmental vision on Disaster Risk Financing and the recommendations of 15th Finance Commission regarding Disaster Risk Management were among the topics of discussion.

DIA-MOW is also designed to understand the role of insurance industry in mitigating the risks by providing risk management solutions. The Insurance industry plays an important role in managing disaster risks and reducing the financial burden by providing a source of funding for post-disaster recovery and reconstruction. The global reinsurance market provides additional source of capital to mitigate the financial impact, diverting the risk from the domestic economy and enhancing the capacity of primary insurers to provide affordable insurance for catastrophe risk financing. There is also the mechanism of reinsurance, whereby risks are spread beyond the country's capacity to bear the shock, as the provisions of reinsurance provide funding from other insurers and other insurance markets. Reinsurers play a key role in managing post disaster financing. III and NIDM are trying to bring like-minded people from insurance and reinsurance sectors to reach out to the people managing risks in different states.

The 3rd Disaster and Insurance Awareness - Monthly Online Webinar (DIA-MOW)

The 3rd DIA-MOU on Disaster Risk Financing and Insurance was held on November 26, 2021, focusing on the needs of the States in the Southern part of India, viz. Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Pondicherry, Tamil Nadu and Telangana.

Mr. Deepak Godbole welcomed the participants of the 3rd MoW. He pointed out that the incidences of disaster are on the rise and researches are being conducted to find out the actual impact of natural disasters and those induced by human actions. Disasters have an indelible impact on human beings as also on the social, financial, and economic environments. Managing the financial impact of disasters is a key challenge for individuals, businesses and governments.

Dr. George E. Thomas briefed about various types of risks, those that can be easily measurable and transferable including those caused by Natural Catastrophes, complex multi-catastrophe risks and residual risks post-insurance. He also spoke about risk management by the insurance sector and how the insurance sector is regulated by global benchmarks and standards keeping the policy holder's protection in view and the challenges faced by insurers due to accumulation of risks. He also gave an overview of insurance products, the working of the insurance mechanism and disaster risk financing.

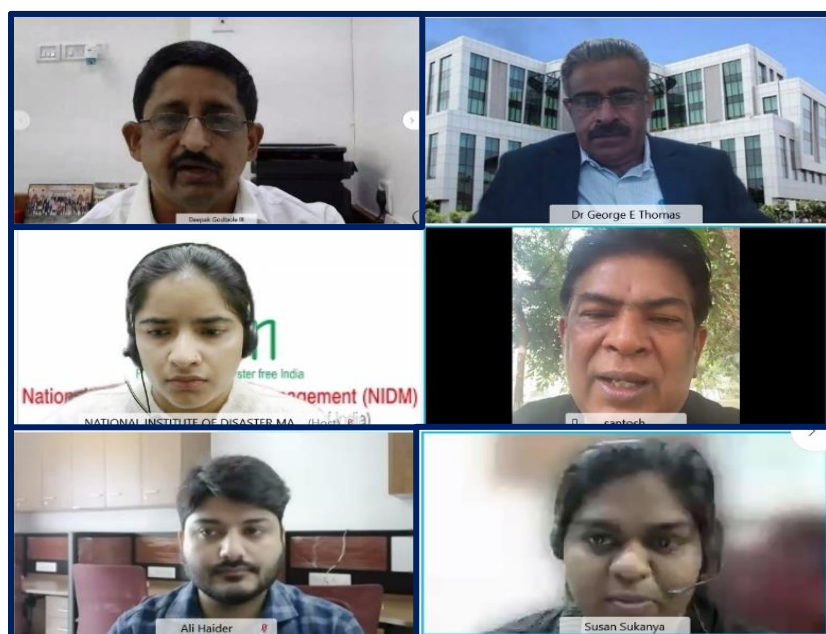
Prof. Santosh Kumar spoke on the importance of Disaster Risk Financing and the governmental vision on DRF based on the recommendations of the 15th Financial Commission (FFC). Financial resilience plays

a very important role in bringing micro institutions and micro financing units together to mitigate risks arising out of disasters. He also said that to educate people about insurance; and how the insurance mechanism can be utilized for building resilience towards disaster risk for public/ private infrastructure, as well as social infrastructure. Different communities of the globe like Turkey, Mexico and the USA were examined, every country's individual strengths and weaknesses were studied and how financial resilience tool was being implemented in other markets were discussed. NIDM conducted this joint study with IIR, to understand the strength of these insurance industries and the concerns in building financial resilience as an initiative of the country leading to a Working Group drawn from insurers and reinsurers and insurance academia. Dr Santosh Kumar stated that the Working Group submitted its report, which acknowledges the importance of insurance, to the Ministry of Home Affairs.

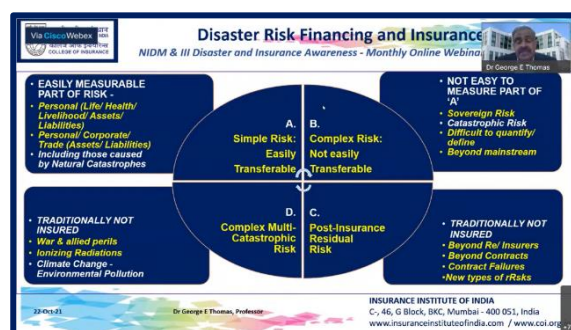
Ms. Shipra Das, Young Professional, NIDM hosted the webinar, explained the webinar format and initiated the proceedings of the 3rd DIA-MOW.

The webinar was attended by Officials from multiple State Disaster Management Authorities and participants representing multiple industries.

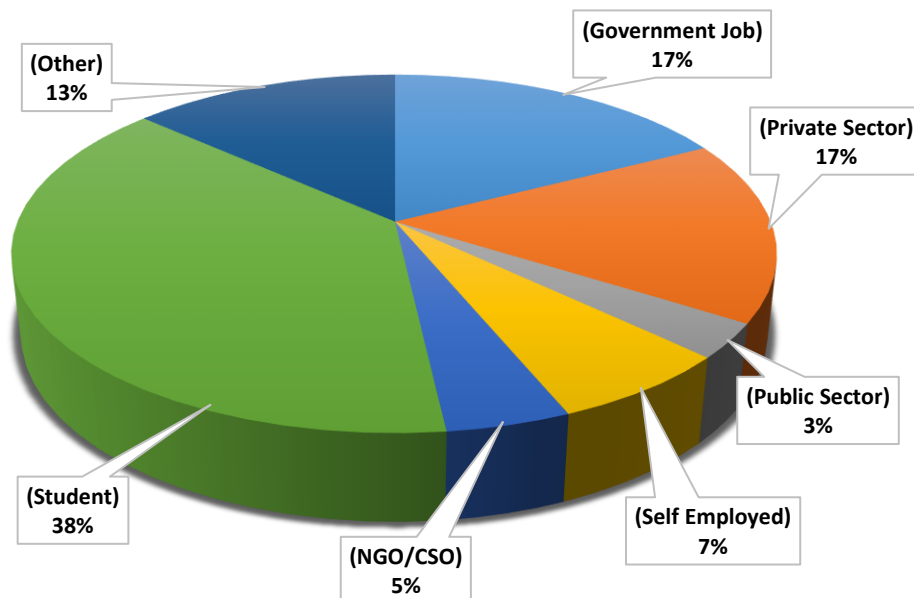

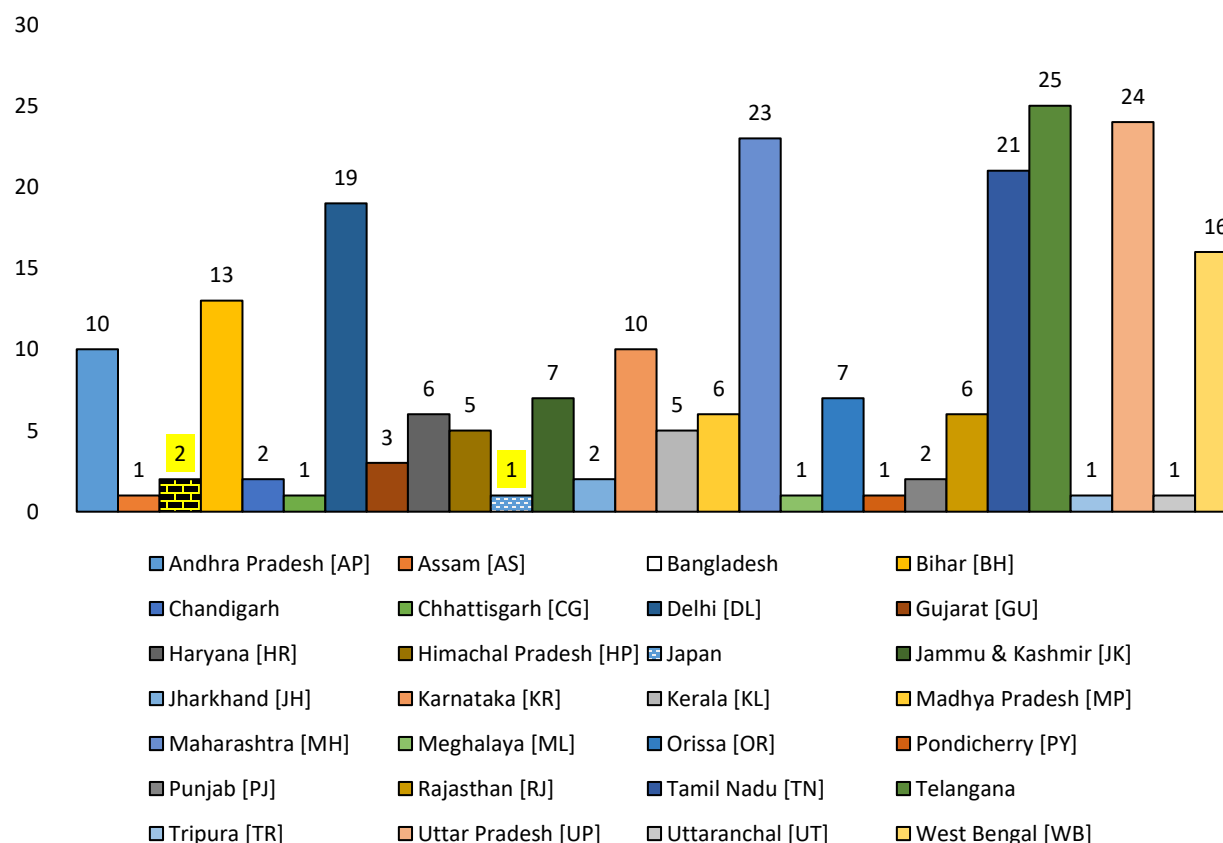

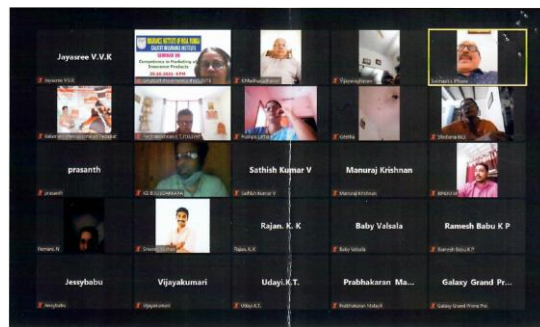
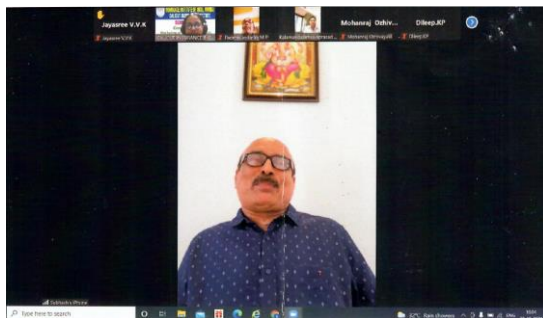
Calicut Insurance Institute has conducted a local seminar on the topic of “Competency in Marketing Insurance Products” on 30th October, 2021 through virtual mode.
