Ayushman Bharat (PM-JAY) was launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 23rd September 2018. Since then PM-JAY has been going from strength to strength and changing the lives of thousands of beneficiaries every day. The NHA has made a positive beginning by setting up robust transactional and monitoring processes and a sturdy IT backbone in place. 30th September 2019 was celebrated as the 1-year anniversary of PM-JAY's launch, a significant milestone as the program transitions from the launch phase to a system strengthening phase.

To mark the completion of one year of PM-JAY a two-day event, 'Arogya Manthan' was organized by the NHA on the 30th September and 1st October 2019. This event was inaugurated by Dr. Harsh Vardhan, Hon'ble Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare and the Minister of State, Hon'ble Bhupendra Choubey. The Honourable Ministers were also present throughout on the second day during the time of presentation of the reports of the Working Groups. The Hon'ble Prime minister, Shri Narendra Modi presided over the valedictory function on the 1st October 2019 alongwith the Honourable Ministers.

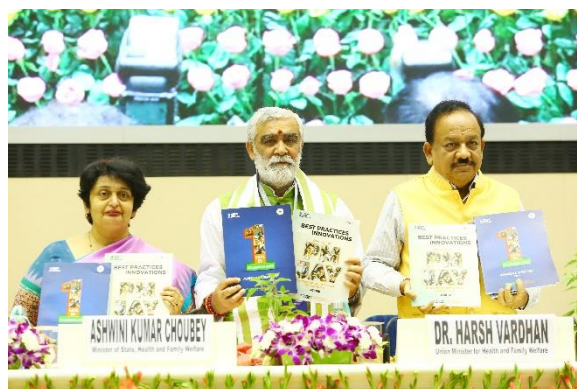
The purpose of the Arogya Manthan was to take stock of the implementation of the scheme, to share experiences and to learn from one another and to discuss the path ahead.

It has also established network two affiliated institutes in the SAARC region i.e. in Sri Lanka and Bhutan and has tied up with Professional Advancement Bangladesh Ltd (PABL) in Bangladesh.
