MoU between III & Nadia Global



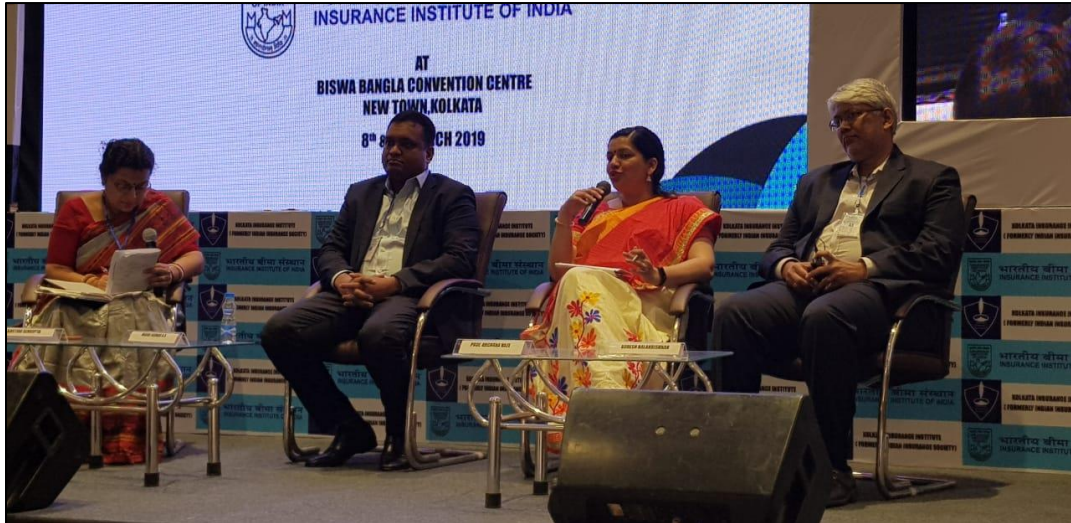
