

Virtual Training Session on Cybersecurity, DPDP Compliance and Insurance Strategies (CVT) on 5 August, 2026



Program Concept and Objectives: In an era of hyper-connectivity, the speed of business is matched only by the velocity of its threats. For the modern enterprise, data is no longer just an asset—it is a significant liability if left unprotected. The integration of technology into every facet of corporate operations has expanded the attack surface, making information security a non-negotiable pillar of the Enterprise Risk Management (ERM) framework.

With the enforcement of the Digital Personal Data Protection (DPDP) Act, the stakes have shifted from mere operational disruption to massive legal and financial penalties. Organizations today face a dual challenge: maintaining robust Cyber Hygiene to prevent breaches and leveraging Cyber Liability Insurance to mitigate the fallout when they occur.

The College of Insurance has developed this specialized program to bridge the gap between technical security and financial risk transfer. This session provides a comprehensive 360-degree view of the cyber ecosystem, ensuring that risk managers, insurers, and intermediaries can navigate the complexities of data compromises and the subsequent claims landscape.
