The role and significance of forensic science has been consistently growing in insurance claim investigations. It has become an essential part of the judicial system, as it utilizes a broad spectrum of sciences to secure information relevant to criminal and legal evidence. Forensic science is very helpful in proving the existence of a crime, the perpetrator of a crime, or a connection to a crime through the examination of physical evidence. Further, the recent developments in Digital Technologies are being exploited by the fraudsters and therefore requires the Investigators also to become adept and smarter in leveraging the technology.
