As a result of technological developments, the machinery and operations of many industries have become increasingly complicated, posing new challenges for insurers.

College of Insurance has developed this course to suit the specific needs of insurance professionals dealing with various Operational risks like Machinery Breakdown (MB) Insurance, Boilers and Pressure Vessels (BPV) Insurance, Electronic Equipment Insurance (EEI) under the Engineering line of business.
