Relevance of the Program:-

Risk is all pervasive; be it physical risk, financial risk or even reputational risk. The individuals as well as the organisations exposed to varieties of risk that need managing them effectively for the continuity of the organisation and to thrive better in its business and trade. Oblivious of the risk is likely to lead to disaster and closure of business. It has been statutory to set up an agile ERM framework under the active supervision of the Board of Directors. In this direction, the role of all in the ranks and file of the organisation cannot be overemphasized. Above all the role of CRO is prominent being a watchdog to manage the risk on all fronts.

Program Objectives:-

The Program is of two days duration. It aims at making the participants aware of–

- Preparing the Risk Management Policy for the organization
- Setting up of an ERM framework to manage the risk and to meet the compliance requirements as well
- Identifying the risk factors and to set up an inventory of risk
- Prioritizing the risk items and analyzing them
- Choosing options on business, based on the risk appetite
- Scanning on the physical risk factors and to address them
- Examining the financial risk factors and the Risk Based Capital requirements
- Preparing the annual Own Risk and Solvency Assessment (ORSA) report
- Strengthening the financial and reputational position of the company
- Leading role of the CRO and Risk Managers/ Risk Owners
