

Classroom Training Session on Challenges in Fighting Fraud - Motor Third Party (CT) - 6-7 July, 2026



Program Concept and Objectives:

Fraud in Motor Third-Party (TP) Insurance poses significant challenges to the industry as a whole. Multiple parties collude to execute TP fraud and manipulate the claim process to maximize pay-outs from insurance providers, thereby affecting the financial stability of insurers and leading to increased premiums for the insured. Fighting fraud is essential to safeguard trust in the insurance eco-system and contribute to community safety. Fighting fraud is a collective effort that involves insurers, regulators, law-enforcement agencies, insurance intermediaries and the general public. To be effective, one should appreciate that technology is used by both fraudsters and fraud-fighters. Investigative processes need to keep pace with the times since they are crucial to identifying and combating fraudulent activities in the industry.

College of Insurance, Insurance Institute of India is conducting a two-day training program to impart knowledge on how to manage the challenges in identifying, preventing and combating fraud in the context of Motor TP Insurance.
