Fighting fraud is essential to safeguard trust in the insurance eco-system and contribute to community safety. Fighting fraud is a collective effort that involves insurers, regulators, law-enforcement agencies, insurance intermediaries and the general public. Investigative processes need to keep pace with the times since they are crucial to identifying and combating fraudulent activities in the industry.

College of Insurance, Insurance Institute of India is conducting a two-day training program to impart knowledge on how to manage the challenges in identifying, preventing and combating fraud in the context of Motor TP Insurance.
