### 1. Accreditation standards

a) NABH

National Accreditation Body for Hospitals and healthcare providers (NABH) is a constituent board of Quality Council of India, set up to establish and operate accreditation programme for healthcare organizations.

The board is supported by all stakeholders that include industry, consumers, government etc. The board has full functional autonomy in its operation. They also scrutinize the healthcare processes and clinical protocols.

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ICD-10 procedure code set (ICD-10-PCS) is another coding methodology used for reporting services and procedures in outpatient and office settings.ICD-10-PCS was developed and is maintained by Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). IRDA mandates the use of this coding system for claims data submission although it is not fully implemented in India.

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
